Brothers benefit from Hippotherapy and Therapeutic Riding

The lobby area of the arena was fairly quiet awaiting the arrival of the 7 p.m. therapeutic riding students. When Jaden and Jonathan entered they were obviously agitated, crying and didn't seem at all interested in riding a horse! Their mother said, "Jaden will calm down as soon as he sits on the horse". If I hadn't been there I don't know that I would have believed the transformation. Once all four of the class' riders were mounted, the arena was quiet again — really - perfectly still!

Of course, class then began with the instructor leading the various exercises and games that make the classes both fun and therapeutic! I talked with Jaden and Jonathan's mother and learned more about how the Miracles program has made a difference in their lives. They started with Hippotherapy this summer and then started in the therapeutic riding classes this fall. She has seen a difference in their balance and core strength and also noted how much calmer they have been.

The boys use a letter board to communicate. As we were beginning the after-class "huddle", Jaden answered a couple of questions, captivating all of us withhow well he could communicate spelling out words one letter at a time. He said, "I feel being on Raven makes my mind relaxed."
