Adaptive Horsemanship

Do you want to learn how to work safely around horses? Understand what they are listening to? Know when a horse is relaxed? Describe a horse's color and markings and know the parts of a horse? Consider signing up for Adaptive Horsemanship. This program teaches those with challenges about horses from the ground. Beyond just the joy of being able to be close to our therapy horses, students learn about grooming, leading, horse care, parts of the horse and being safe around horses. Our next adaptive horsemanship classes start May 18th and will run for 5 weeks.

Our volunteers are nothing if not resilient!

For our first training of the year, they braved very cold temperatures and an arena that quickly filled with dust! (It was too cold to turn on the sprinklers that help us keep the dust to a minimum.) Luckily conditions are a bit better now and we look forward to additional trainings 4/23, 5/21, 6/25, 7/30, 8/27 and 9/24.
