When I think about what makes Miracles in Motion the inspiring place it is, I think of each individual who has generously given their time, talents, and resources. Their contributions are the heart of our success. I see the changes and the happiness it brings to our participants each day. I see the difference being made by our instructors, therapists, horses, and volunteers; there is so much to be grateful for.

Miracles has an unwavering commitment to the well-being and development of our students and riders. Our programs have been instrumental in helping our riders overcome some of their challenges. Riders form a bond with their horse and friendships with the volunteers that enrich their lives in so many ways. During the riding season, we held hippotherapy with ChildServe (in Coralville) and the University of Iowa Stead Family Children's Hospital. We also held multiple sessions of Adaptive Horsemanship and Adaptive Riding. We added two sessions of the Veterans' Program — which was successful and will be back next year. The barn teams were very busy preparing tack as our horses were used over 700 times!

We hosted three events this year. In July, we celebrated the long-awaited new Busse Barn Complex at our Open House: celebrating the incredible donors, subcontractors, volunteers, staff, and work groups who made this project possible. In October we hosted our 7th annual Boo at the Barn! We had close to 500 people at the center. This is a free and accessible event thanks to our event sponsors. Our third event was a Volunteer Appreciation Event to show our gratitude to our volunteers who work so hard all year long to make Miracles happen.

This is just a small snapshot of the past year at Miracles. I am grateful for all the invaluable support, enthusiasm and generosity Miracles receives. With our strategic plan in place, Miracles is on to shared successes and new beginnings.



\$35,100


