Miracles in Motion is a PATH Premier Accredited Center. PATH stands for Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship. Why does that matter? It comes down to three reasons: safety, high standards, and quality of program.

Every year our center signs a compliance statement stating that the center is operating in compliance with all the mandatory and applicable standards that are required. Every 5 years, Miracles goes through an extremely rigorous audit of all the standards. That audit was just conducted, and Miracles once again passed! It takes the entire staff and volunteers to ensure that Miracles adheres to the guidelines and standards. To everyone, kudos!

Since this organization's inception in 1988, Miracles has been a PATH Premier Center. As of now we are the only PATH Premier Center in the state of Iowa. Being under the PATH umbrella, we focus on specific guidelines to ensure that

participants in our programs receive the best possible instruction and that Miracles adheres to the highest quality standards. These standards are best practices for our classes, emphasizing safety of participants, instructors, therapists, volunteers, and equines, and providing the basis for quality equine-assisted services. Our instructors implement the many standards daily and so are the integral part of ensuring quality
